The Saskatchewan Roughriders Centennial Committee wish to choose three (3) original 2-dimensional student works of art as part of this centennial celebration. Each of the three (3) pieces will become part of a permanent 2010 Rider Centennial Art Collection to accompany commissions from professional Saskatchewan artists. Note that the professional artist commission will be identified through a separate competition. All mediums will be considered. Student artists are asked to create original works of art using high quality, archival materials. Selected recipients (3) will receive a prize package including \$500 cash payment.

The Saskatchewan Roughrider organization recognizes the contribution of Saskatchewan youth to our organization. We are very pleased to offer this opportunity as one of many components of the Centennial Celebration 2010 year. We encourage all young artists to participate.

# APPENDIX

## Eligibility

The competition is open to any Saskatchewan-based student artist Ages 14 to 18 in the 2009/2010 school year.

## General Requirements / Thematic Relevance

The Saskatchewan Roughriders Football Club Inc. is requesting submissions of artwork that incorporate and reflect the following:

Theme: 100 YEARS OF PRIDE

Background: The Riders 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary is officially marked on January 1, 2010. The anniversary is a significant milestone for the football club, the players (past and present), the fans and the community. The overall celebration goal is to celebrate one hundred years of the Saskatchewan Roughrider Football Club by paying tribute to and recognizing all the stakeholders (i.e. fans, shareholders, players, coaches, volunteers and business partners).

Key themes of the celebration to help guide artist concepts are as follows:

*Heritage* - documentation and celebration of the history and accomplishments of the Riders over 100 years of building a winning organization.

*Community* - linkage to the many Saskatchewan communities of interest that have supported of the Riders.

*Education* - focus on future leader development by reinforcing the Riders core values with students of all ages. (Core values: our fans, sponsors and the community, a winning philosophy in all our endeavours, integrity, sportsmanship, fairness and respect, openness and accountability, our tradition – past, present and future)

*Generations* - recognizing the differences in needs/interests between the four generations of stakeholders that have contributed to the 100 years of success.

*Legacy* - building a sustainable program framework that reinforces the Rider's perpetual contribution to Saskatchewan.

## Criteria and Submission Requirements

- Proposer must demonstrate the capacity to create an original work of art using high quality, archival materials. For example, professional grade paints and substrates. Work must be two-dimensional. All mediums will be considered.
  - Submission deadline is February 15, 2010.
  - The Proposer is to submit a current resume/biography. (include all contact information i.e. name, address, telephone, email)

- The Proposer is to provide a digital image of their entry. (Please do not send original artwork.) The image may be submitted in the format of a slide, photograph or CD-ROM (JPEG or TIF images with minimal resolution of 150 dpi). The image must be identified with the title, completion date, medium used and size. Specific dimensions and materials must be noted. In accordance with environmental friendliness, a class representative or teacher is permitted to submit a single CD containing the images of several students' work." Please clearly identify if there is more than one artist/CD.
- Minimum size requirements are 24" x 30"
- Interested parties must submit before **5:00 pm CST, Monday, February 15, 2010**. The proposal shall be delivered to the office of:

- Limit of one submission per artist.

### **Selection Criteria**

Responses will be evaluated using, but not limited to, the following criteria:

- Creativity and originality of the proposed work
  - Thematic relevance (see General Requirements/Thematic Relevance)
  - Statement describing the Artist's understanding of the project
